SCOPE OF WORK:

This project was an emergency installation to replace a leaking steam pipeline between Buildings 2 and 3 located at the US Army's Natick Soldier System Center. Excavation was performed to facilitate the repair under the roadway and the installation of approximately 100 feet of perma-pipe steam line. Other related work included; supply and installation of two hot water boilers, a hot water heater, a low pressure steam boiler and heating coils to building One. Site work followed to ensure that the area was returned to its pervious, acceptable condition.
