### Project Details

**PROJECT LOCATION:** Newport Naval Station, Newport, RI

**CONTRACT NO.:** #N40085-09-C-9766

**SCOPE OF WORK:**

The project required demolition of two roofing systems and the installation of new Syplast SBS Modified roofing panels and pre-formed insulated wall panels at each location. Other work included the removal and reinstallation of three antennas and soffit lights at Building 690. Masonry repairs were needed to install wall flashing and scanning of concrete was completed as at both roofs. The square footage for Building 690 is 9,009 and for Building 1288 is 31,524 SF.

The buildings are occupied by Navy Headquarters at Building 690 and the Law School (JAG Corps) at Building 1288.

The project required cranes to remove and install material at both roofs. Coordination with the Naval staff was required to install new roof drains on both buildings as the buildings were occupied during this work.

Winter weather conditions required a job shut-down in December, 2009, which was fully supported by the customer. Work will resume in April, 2010 and is targeted for completion in May, 2010.
